

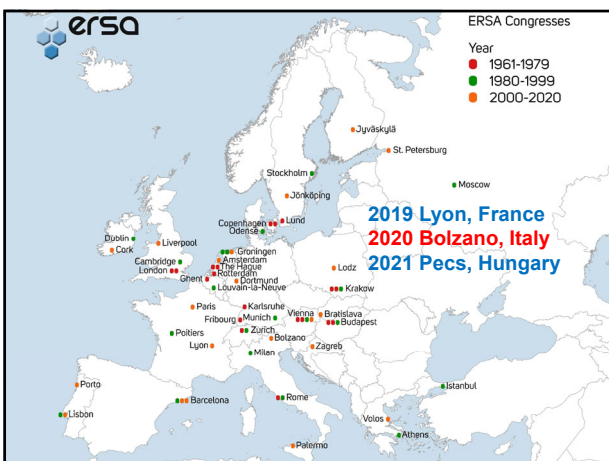



ERSA Congress
